ADDITIONAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

7. The main colour of clothing must not be white.
8. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to this event.
9. The final order in a group shall be determined as per ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
7. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
8. All competitors will be required to umpire.
9. Where possible, all events will be played in groups.
10. All competitors must report to the top table on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the Referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
11. Should there be insufficient entries in any event the Referee reserves the right to cancel that event/merge such event and/or place the entrant in a similar event.
12. The referee's decision shall be final on a point of law and on any question arising not provided for in these regulations, or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof.
13. Players must have been born in 1994 or later for youth singles, 1997 or later for the junior events, 2000 for cadet, 2002 for minor and 2004 for mini minors.
14. The age category events will be seeded using the TTS ranking list.
15. For banded events players will be placed in bands and seeded based on the Ratings Central ratings.
16. If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, this will be on the basis of last received first out.
17. Payment must be completed with entry. Cash on the day of tournament will not be accepted.
18. 40mm 3* celluloid balls will be used for the event.
19. Free on site car parking is available (at the owners risk).
20. No refunds of entry fees will be made after the date of the draw.
21. Junior, Cadet and Minor events will count towards Table Tennis Scotland rankings.
